



King Lists

All dates indicate period of rule and are to be taken as approximate as they are often uncertain, especially in the earlier centuries. They are based for rulers of Mesopotamia (Sumerian, Babylonian, Assyrian) on Regine Pruzsinsky's list in Gonzalo Rubio, ed. *A Handbook of Ancient Mesopotamia* (Boston and Berlin: de Gruyter, in press). Descent is not always clear: when it is certain, successive kings are connected with |; when possible, by ?; when no direct family connection existed, successive rulers are separated by a blank space.

1 Akkad Dynasty




2 Third Dynasty of Ur








