

LINGUA INGLESE 2
Prof. Brownlees, Test 27 May 2019

- Written test 27 May 13.00, Aula 10, Via Laura
- Students who do not do the written test on 27 May can do it at one of the three summer *appelli* or at a later *appello* from autumn onwards. If there are many students on 27 May, the students will be divided into two groups (13.15-14.00; 14.15-15.00)
- The test consists of 20 questions (see examples in lecture notes p.5).
- Pass mark is 12/20 (half a mark is deducted for every mistake)
- Students can take the test if they are enrolled in Prof. Brownlees's course
- Results will be put up on Moodle page afternoon of 27 May or morning of 28 May
- Students who pass the test can do the oral part of exam on 28-29 May. Times to be given after completion of test and notification of results on Moodle page.
- Students who do not pass the test can do it again either at the second or third summer *appello*. If a student does not pass the test on 27 May they cannot try again on 10 June.
- The oral part of test (see examples p.5,6 of lecture notes) will be on 28 May and 29 May (the oral part of exam will also be in the regular summer *appelli* and all other regular *appelli*)
- If a student does the oral part of the exam that indicates that the mark for the written test has been accepted
- Students who pass the written test on 27 May but do not wish to do the oral exam have until 3 June to decide if they wish to accept the mark of the written test. If I do not receive an email by 3 June 5 pm saying the mark has not been accepted the mark is considered valid and cannot be changed.
- If a student passes the written test, but does not accept the final mark based on both the written test mark and the oral exam mark, the student can return to do the oral exam from the second *appello* onwards. The student cannot do the written test again
- The final mark for Lingua Inglese 2 is based on the *lettorato* (including the three lectures) and Prof. Brownlees's exam.
